Excitement is stirring as we prepare for our 2019 Summer Camping Season! This summer, our campers will be challenged to seek God through Chapel messages, scripture memorization, and Bible study. The purpose of Camp Michael is to provide a unique outdoor environment where our campers can enjoy a specifically designed program that encourages them to take new steps in their physical, social, mental, and spiritual lives. Camp Michael also has a doctor nearby who is on call 24 hours a day in case of any emergency. We are licensed by the State of Michigan and are regularly inspected.

Camp Michael is a non-profit, independent ministry of local churches of like faith and practice. The fees for campers do not cover the total cost of operating Camp Michael. Camp is supported by faithful prayer and financial support from churches and individuals. We trust the Lord to provide for the needs of Camp Michael.
