GENERAL INFORMATION

Reservations are confirmed when the completed registration form with the required non-refundable deposit of \$25 is received in our office. Your registration fee and form does not hold a bunk for a cabin mate...their registration fee and form need to be turned in quickly as well.

Campers must remain on the camp grounds at all times. Campers will not be permitted to leave. Campers remain in assigned cabin from lights out to morning bell. Campers must be present and on time for all meetings and meals. The order of the day is the camp program. Everyone participates unless prevented by illness.

Arrival: JUNIOR, JR HIGH, & SR HIGH CAMPERS: Check in will begin at 2:00 PM on Monday, in the Camp Office. Camp kicks off at 3:00 PM. *(Please try and arrive before 2:30 PM.)* First meal will be dinner. PRIMARY CAMPERS: Check in will begin at 11:00 AM on Monday, in the Camp Office. Camp kicks off at 12:00 PM. *(Please try and arrive before 11:30 AM.)* First meal will be lunch. At registration, you and your camper(s) will meet with the Health Officer before heading to the dorms. The Health Officer will collect all medications, bug spray, sunscreen, and electronics. A lice check will be administered at this time.

Late Arrival: Should your arrival be delayed past 3:00 PM or 12:00 PM for Primary, please call the camp office at 810-724-6966 to hold reservations and to give us an estimated arrival time.

Departure: *(Please indicate those authorized to pick up your child on the Registration Form.)* Campers must be signed out at departure. JUNIOR, JR HIGH, & SR HIGH CAMPERS: Check out will begin at 10:00 AM on Saturday, in the Chapel. PRIMARY CAMPERS: Check out will begin at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, in the Chapel.

Walk-In Policy: We cannot guarantee admission for walk-in campers once camp is full.

What to Bring: Bible, bedding, pillow, towels, toiletries, camera, flashlight, swimsuit, beach towel, cover-up, jacket, clothes for activities and cool or rainy days, dress clothes for evening Chapel Services, bug spray, sunscreen, spending money for Snack Shack & Hugga Mug Coffee Cabin—most campers bring \$20-\$40. Additional items for purchase: T-shirt \$12, Camp Photo \$5, Hat \$15, Mug \$15

Do Not Bring: Cell Phones, or any type of music/media device, weapons, alcohol, drugs, tobacco or cigarettes of any kind, fireworks, magazines, or clothing with worldly advertising or rock group imprinting.

Ladies/Girls Dress: Clothing should come at least to the top of the knee. Please no low necklines, narrow sleeveless/tank tops, or skin-tight fashions. Please bring skirts or dresses for the evening services. For water activities, please wear dark shirts and shorts over swimwear. For girls-only swim times, a cover up must be worn to the swimming pond. A one-piece swimsuit or tankini that overlaps at the waist is acceptable.

Men/Boys Dress: Clothing should come at least to the top of the knee. Please bring long pants/jeans and collared shirts for the evening services. For water activities, please wear dark shirts and shorts/swim trunks. For boys-only swim times, swim trunks are acceptable. A t-shirt must be worn to the swimming pond.

Camp Michael reserves the right to ask anyone to change his or her outfit if, in the evaluation of the staff, it does not comply with these standards.

Camp Nurse: A registered Health Officer is on camp grounds 24 hours a day as required by Michigan State Law. At every water front activity there is a Red Cross Certified Life Guard overseeing all safety requirements. Camp Michael also has a doctor nearby who is on call 24 hours a day in case of any emergency. We are licensed by the State of Michigan and we are regularly inspected.

Lost and Found: Lost items not requested within 30 days will be disposed of.

Meals: All meals are included in the price of the camping program. Those on special diets must bring their own necessary supplements, already fully cooked. A refrigerator, microwave, toaster oven, freezer and dry storage will be available. *(Please contact the camp office for a camp menu.)*
